## TRAVEL SHOW OF CUBA

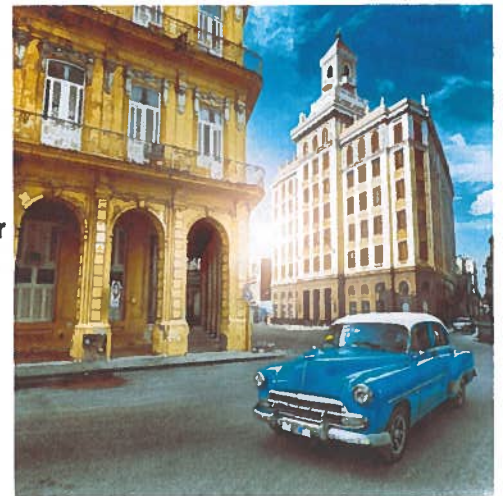

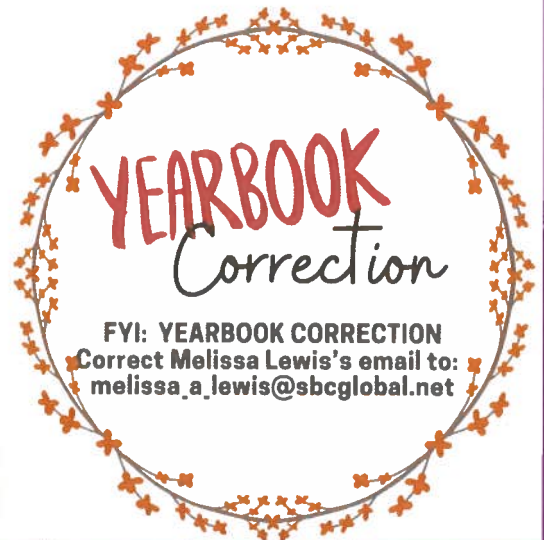
